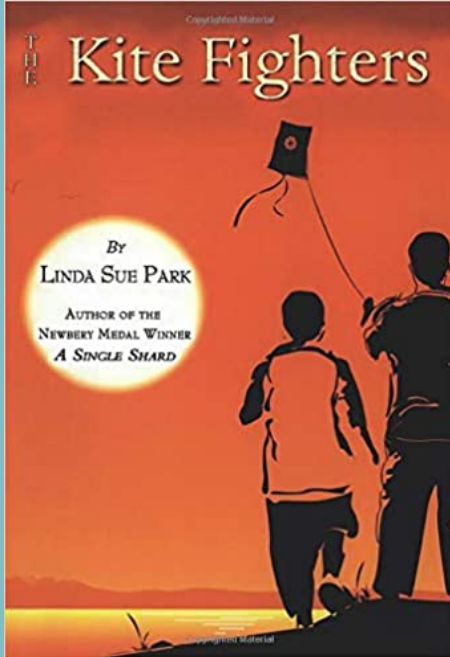

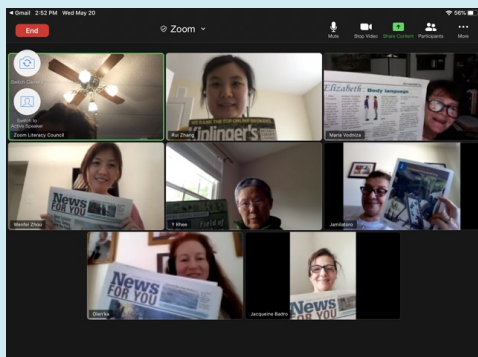

Student Class Schedule

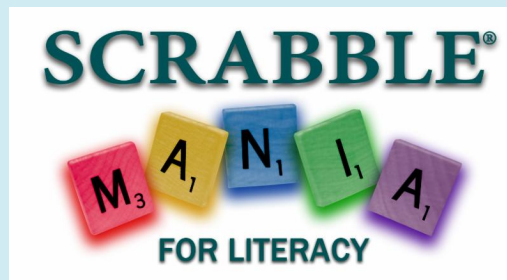
