

ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (ESL) CLASSES

Beginner Level Classes:

- **Beginner Conversation:** MONDAYS & WEDNESDAYS - Beginner Literacy Level (6/20/2022 - 8/22/2022)
- **Beginner Conversation:** THURSDAYS 2:00 – 3:00 PM Low/High Beginner level (4/7/2022 - 6/30/2022)
- **High Beginning ESL:** MONDAYS 4:00 - 5:00 PM (4/4/2022 - 6/27/2022) Listening, speaking, reading, & writing.

Intermediate Level Classes:

- **Writing 1:** TUESDAYS 12:00 - 1:30 PM (4/26/2022 - 6/28/2022) Low Intermediate students are introduced to simple and compound sentences and discuss and use grammar in their writing. (Additional reading and writing assignments to be completed for homework.)
- **Writing 2:** WEDNESDAYS 1:00 – 3:00 PM (4/27/2022 – 6/29/2022) High Intermediate students are introduced to different paragraph forms and form simple, compound, and complex sentences. (Additional reading and writing assignments to be completed for homework.)
- **Student-Led Conversation:** TUESDAYS 3:30 – 4:30 PM (4/26/2022 – 6/28/2022) Intermediate/Advanced students deliver a final presentation to the class.
- **Intermediate Conversation:** THURSDAYS 3:30 – 4:30 PM (4/7/2022 - 6/30/2022)
- **Intermediate ESL:** TUESDAYS 7:00 – 8:00 PM (4/13/2022 – 6/21/2022)
- **ESL Listening and Speaking:** WEDNESDAYS 11:30 AM – 12:30 PM (4/13/2022 – 6/6/2022) High-Intermediate students will role play everyday situations to strengthen conversation skills.
- **ESL Summer Book Club (for students and tutors):** Will meet on WEDNESDAYS 1:00 – 2:30 PM (7/6, 7/13, and 7/20/2022).
