It's Working! Literacy Council Expands Workplace Program



Sometimes the best-laid plans do succeed. This certainly is the case for the Literacy Council of Frederick County. Plans to expand its Workplace Literacy Program were given the green light last year in the form of a multi-year grant from the Maryland Department of Commerce, Office of Tourism.

The Council is now ready to build on success it has experienced in recent years through workplace programs designed to improve the English language literacy—and everyday life skills—of employees working in the hospitality services industry in Frederick County. The grant started in July, and the first new employer joining the initiative is Cohenterprises, a local, family-owned commercial land development company operating three area hotels.


